

## CHALK HILL

## estate bottled 2011 Russian River Pinot Noir

VINEYARD
Since its founding in the 1972, Chalk Hill Estate has been recognized as one of
California's benchmark producers. Our 1300+-acre property is located at the
convergence of a number of diverse climates, soils and terrains in the
northeastern hills of Sonoma County. Our new Trenton Road Vineyard, a few
miles west of the winery, is set in the in the center of the Russian River Valley
AVA. In addition to the 48 acres of vines, it is home to 140 acres of native
woodlands, two groves of redwoods, steep hillsides and stunning views of the
valley and mountains. While it bears many similarities to our Chalk Hill Estate,
the cooler conditions at Trenton road make it an ideal site for Pinot Noir.
A cool, wet spring and heavy rains in early June affected the set and reduced
the potential size of the crop. July and August were also unseasonably cool
making us wonder if things would ever get on track. Fortunately a week of hot
temperatures in mid-September allowed the fruit to fully ripen and we
harvested all of our Pinot prior to the rains in October.
TASTING -
Our inaugural Pinot Noir is a wonderful example of the Russian River Valley
AVA. A blend of clone 37 and clone 777, it delivers all the wild, exotic spice
one expects from this cool, maritime region. The aromas are saturated with
cherries, raspberries, tea leaves and pipe tobacco. The palate adds fig and
smoked meat to the mix. The finish is rich, long and elegant.
